

# KEEC Pre-Conference Workshop: Power Up with Energy Education!



Ignite your students' curiosity with this pre-conference workshop sponsored by the Kansas Association for Conservation and Environmental Education, Kansas Corporation Commission/State Energy Office and the Prairie Park Nature Center. This Energy Education workshop for formal and non-formal educators is designed to energize your curricula and environmental education programs. Experience innovative ideas and hands-on activities for exploring energy, and enjoy field studies at the Bowersock Dam & Hydroelectric Plant. Participants will learn to conduct energy audits using light and energy meters, and will be able to teach students how to do audits in their own homes. Information about energy-related school projects such as the Wind for Schools Program and energy conservation measures such as efficient lighting are also included. These projects are eligible for grant funding under the Kansas Green Schools Program.
